### CONSIGNMENT CONTRACT

Consignor's Guidelines, Rules, Terms & Conditions

**This document is part of the Consignment Contract for each of the animals you are consigning to this sale.**

**By signing the Consignment Contract, you acknowledge that you have read this document and agree to abide by the guidelines, rules, terms and conditions set forth in it.**

#### **CONSIGNMENT:**

- Consignment fee is as stated on Page 1 of the Consignment Contract. **IT IS NON-REFUNDABLE.** You cannot wait and have your Consignment Fee deducted from your check after your animal sells.
- If you are selling a horse or donkey with a baby by its side, you are only required to pay \$25.00 consignment fee, which covers both.
- Consignment fees can be paid by cash, check or PayPal (ozandgin@AOL.com). Please put WNCMHC sale in the notes for PayPal.
- Please complete all information on the Consignment Contract. It can be mailed or e-mailed to me (ozandgin@AOL.com)
- You are encouraged to send pictures. I will post as space allows. Make sure the pictures are identified so the posted online will be accurate. **PLEASE DO NOT TEXT PICTURES. I CANNOT DOWNLOAD.**
- Horses and/or donkeys that are consigned after the catalog deadline will be sold at the end of the cataloged animals.
- If you know a problem with paperwork or registration, **YOU MUST DISCLOSE THAT INFORMATION.** Otherwise, your animal will be sold with guaranteed paperwork (or as a grade animal) and **YOU** will be responsible for resolving any issues with the buyer. If you sell an animal "With Registration Application" it means you have included all necessary paperwork for the buyer to complete transfer and registration processes. If you use the words "Eligible for Registration" the animal will be considered grade quality unless you can supply information otherwise. We will attempt to have blank transfer of sales for AMHA and AMHR on site if you need forms.
- All animals that are advertised to be "lab tested or vet checked" must have paperwork to substantiate that. E.G.: parentage qualification, color/pattern testing, dwarf testing, pregnancy check, etc.
- **ALL ANIMALS CONSIGNED MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS (EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA) TEST WITH 12 MONTHS OF SALE AND A HEALTH CERTIFICATE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF SALE DATE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Lot number placement in sale: This is handled on a first come, first served basis and only implemented after the Consignment Contract and Fee are received. We will make every attempt to place you where you desire in the sale.
- By signing this Contract, Seller acknowledges that all information submitted for catalogs to be true and accurate to the best of Seller's knowledge.

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### CATALOGS:

- Please notify me as soon as possible if you are not bringing or are substituting an animal that has already been consigned and put in the catalog.
- Consignments will be posted in two locations: Western NC Miniature Horse Club on Face Book Page and in the sale program. Also [www.silverbellefarms.com](http://www.silverbellefarms.com)
- Face Book Page: Western NC Miniature Horse Club. Photos will be posted along with information. Sellers MAY NOT comment or answer questions on the WNCMHC FB Page. Please feel free to SHARE the FB Page to your personal FB Page. You can comment all you want on your personal FACE BOOK Page, but not on the WNCMHC Page.
- Sale Program: Photos will NOT be included in the Sale Program.
- The deadline to be in all Programs is two weeks prior to sale. Any consignments that come in after that will be posted if time allows and be sold at the end of the consigned animals.
- PLEASE SEND IN YOUR CONSIGNMENTS AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE. WE WANT PEOPLE TO SEE WHAT YOU HAVE TO SELL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

### CHECK-IN:

- You may check in with your animals at the A.G. Center on Friday, September 28, beginning at 12 noon. The A.G. Center is located just off exit 86 on I-40 at the 226 South exit. It is just 1 mile south from I-40 exit on the left past the prison and across from the Saddle and Bridle Club entrance. Easy to find from I-40 in Marion. The facility has wash facilities and parking but no direct hook up available for camping. Horses will be stalled inside the sale barn as allowed and overflow will be outside under roof. Loves Transport exit just off I-40. Many convenient close restaurants and accommodations.
- We will accept check-ins Friday night until 9 pm and again on Saturday morning beginning at 7, but it is recommended to have your animals checked in prior to public preview, which begins at 5:00 Friday night.
- If you have not previously registered, you must pay your \$25.00 Consignment Fee in cash and complete the Consignment Contract at the time of check-in.
- We will check your paperwork to help make sure you have everything you need. All paperwork will stay with the Auction Staff until your animal is sold.
- ALL ANIMALS FOR SALE MUST HAVE THEIR OWN HALTERS AND LEAD ROPES, WHICH WILL BE LEFT WITH THEM FOR THE NEW BUYER. Failure do so means we supply a halter and lead rope and the amount will be deducted from your final check.
- If the weather has turned cold and your animal has been clipped, it must have a blanket. If you notify me in advance, I may be able to supply a blanket if you do not have one.
- We will measure your animal and record the height on a chart. A tag with the animal's lot number will be attached to the halter and it will be taken to a stall with a matching tag on the stall.
- It is your responsibility to feed and water your animal. Bring water buckets with your name on them. There is water available on site.
- You may tape or staple copies of registration papers, photos or other information about your animal on the stall gate.
- Feel free to spend as much time with your animals as you want.
