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PREVIEW (Friday)

- The public has been invited to preview the animals in their stalls on Friday from 5 to 8 p.m.
- I am asking that all Sellers or their representatives be available in the auction barn to answer questions about your animal.
- During public preview, it is asked that you remove any blankets so the potential buyer can see them.
- I have put a lot of my energy into bringing potential new mini owners to the auction and hope to educate them in all aspects of mini ownership. Please take time to talk to them, make them feel welcome and explain why we all love these minis so much. Tell them about showing, driving or just having fun with your mini. Taking time to be nice DOES pay off in the end!

SALE PROCESS (Saturday)

- Beginning at 9 am, we will sell any used tack and equipment.
- Immediately following the sale of used tack and equipment, but no later than 11 a.m., we will begin selling animals in the ring.
- Donkeys will be sold first, then Horses.
- Animals will be lined up in the sale barn. You may lead your own animal in the ring if you wish. One of our staff members will assist you if you wish.
- You may NO SALE the animal, but you MUST DO SO BEFORE IT LEAVES THE RING. Otherwise the sale is completed when the auctioneer says SOLD. If you No SALE your animal, please be respectful to those who DID bid. There is a \$0.00 no sale charge but consignment fees are not refunded.
- You must still get paperwork from the office on a NO SALE animal prior to removing your animal from the sale barn.
- NO PRIVATE SALES may take place on auction premises.

FINAL SALES:

If you have sold an animal or tack at the auction, payment will be mailed to you one week after the sale. We will deposit checks and cash in the WNCMHC account on Monday, October 1 and we must allow for 5 days for checks to clear. If you paid by debit card or credit card there is a fee for use that will be charged to you. There will be a \$25 returned check fee on any checks that do not clear the bank in 5 days.
